

## Log Cabin Ornaments



Cut:  
Red center, 1 inch square

Cut strips:

Light fabric	Dark fabric
1 inch length x 1 inch wide	1.5 length x 1 inch wide
1.5 inch length x 1 inch wide	2 inch length x 1 wide
2 inch length x 1 wide	2.5 inch x 1 inch
2.5 inch x 1 inch	3 inch x 1 inch
3 inches x 1.25 inches (this is wider so can trim after sewing)	3.75 inches x 1.25 inches
3.75 inches x 1.25 inches	4.25 inches x 1.25 inches

1. Sew strips together using  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seams. Trim finished blocks so outer strips are about  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches wide. (Finished strips will be  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch wide.)
2. Cut squares the size of the finished blocks for the backs of the ornaments (about 4 inches square).
3. Pin 6 inch ribbon in place. Sew front and back together using  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch seams. Leave bottom or side opening for turning. Slightly round all four corners for better looking corners.
4. Turn right side out. Stuff with loose fiberfill. Hand stitch the opening closed.

The angel ornaments in the above picture were cut from printed fabric. (It's hard to find suitable fabric.) I free-motion quilted around the outline of the angel and also in the outer spaces (you can see the gold thread).
