block size: 12" × 12"

materials

(based on 40"-wide fabric)

- ¼ yd. orange
- 1/8 yd. green
- 1/8 yd. blue-green (bkgrnd)
- 1/8 yd. purple
- 1/8 yd. black (leading)
- cotton thread
- foundation material (paper)


making the block

[1] Make 4 copies each of the *Interlocked Squares* foundation units A–C (see page 2 for full-size foundation patterns).

[2] Using the shaded areas of the foundation as a guide for color placement, stitch the units as shown.




Make 4



[3] Baste the units within the 1/4" seam allowance. Trim the units along the dashed line.

[4] Matching the lowercase letters in the seam allowances, of the units, join units A–C in alphabetical order to make the quarters of the block.

[5] Join the sections in pairs to make the halves of the block then join the halves to complete the block.
