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Part of our library of stained glass quilt block designs, this block may be used in any project. Mix and match them to create a unique quilt.

block size: 12" × 12"

materials

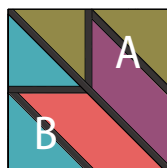
(based on 40"-wide fabric)

- ◆ 1/8 yd. dark peach
- ◆ 1/8 yd. light green
- ◆ 1/8 yd. light blue
- ◆ 1/8 yd. purple
- ◆ 1/8 yd. black (leading)
- ◆ cotton thread
- ◆ foundation material (paper)

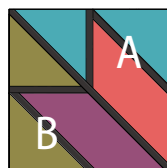
making the block

[1] Make 4 copies each of the *Star of the Milky Way* foundation units A and B (see page 2 for full-size foundation patterns).

[2] Using the shaded areas of the foundation as a guide for color placement, stitch the units as shown.

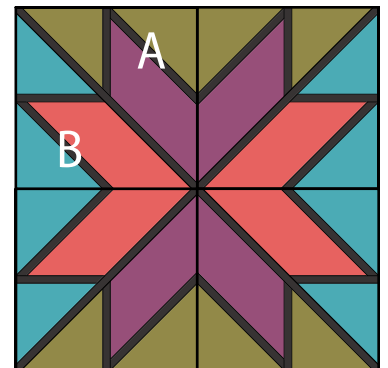

[3] Baste the units within the 1/4" seam allowance. Trim the units along the dashed line.

[4] Join the A and B units to make the quarters the block.

[5] To finish the block, stitch the quarters together in pairs, then join the halves to make the block.
