## Modern Squares block

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Part of our library of stained glass quilt block designs, this block may be used in any project. Mix and match them to create a unique quilt. block size: $12^{1 " ~} \times 12^{1}$ materials (based on 40"-wide fabric)

- $1 / 8$ yd. green (center)
- $1 / 8$ yd. light blue
- $1 / 8$ yd. medium blue
- $1 / 8$ yd. light purple
- $1 / 8$ yd. medium purple
- 1/8 yd. black (leading)
- cotton thread
- foundation material (paper)
making the block
[1] Make 4 copies of the Modern Squares foundation unit (see page 2 for full-size foundation pattern).
[2] Using the shaded areas of the foundation as a guide for color placement, stitch the units as shown.


Make 4

[3] Baste the units within the $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Trim the units along the dashed line.
[4] Join the sections in pairs to make the halves of the block, then join the halves to complete the block.
