



Star Point Block Paper Templates

NOT Paper Piecing

These paper templates take the place of using the 3" scored acrylic template I have been sending out. Since I am providing paper templates you won't need to cut the 30 degree angle anymore.

1. Cut out the paper templates using only the white part. The green is not part of the template
2. Pin the templates to your fabric and trim the fabric to the templates.
You can leave the paper on or take it off. It doesn't matter but you will need to remove it after if you leave it on to sew.
3. Sew the left side onto the center first. Open and iron the seam.
4. Sew the right side onto the other side of the center. Open and iron the seam
5. Lay the joined fabrics on a mini cutting mat
6. Use a 2 1/2" template to cut out the Star Point Block.

This size will make a 12 1/2" quilt block if you use 6 rows 6 blocks in a row
